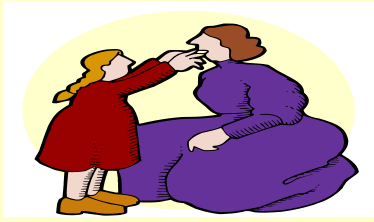
On Wednesday, February 27th an assembly was held to recognize students who had received a Heart for demonstrating our monthly Character Trait, "THOUGHTFUL."
