## **Pulaski Day**

Please be aware that on March 5, 2007 all Chicago Public Schools will be closed in observance of Casimir Pulaski Day. Cleveland will reopen on March 6, 2007.

## **ISAT Testing**

Beginning the week of Monday, March 12, 2007 students in grades 3rd to 8th grade will be taking the Illinois Standards Achievement Test (ISAT). It is very important that students are in attendance and on time that week. Please make sure that your child is well rested and eats a good breakfast. The ISAT is the test used to measure Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) under the No Child Left Behind Act (NCLB). Students are tested in reading and math in Grades 3-8 and science in Grades 4 and 7. Beginning with the 2007 exam, students in Grades 5 and 8 will be tested in writing. **There will be no after-school program during this week.**
